Aaron Muhs – VP of Fundraising

- Mr. Muhs discussed BSCO Budgets:
  - o Pre-Covid the budget was approximately \$145k
  - o 2020-21 ~\$40K,
  - o 2021-22~\$65K
  - o 2022-23 \$148K which assumed a normal year (not Covid impacted)
- The goal is to have one year worth of BSCO spending in reserves
