# IN AN EMERGENCY TAKE ACTION



## **HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.**

### **STUDENTS**

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced  
Do business as usual

### **ADULTS**

Close and lock the door  
Account for students and adults  
Do business as usual



## **SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors.**

### **STUDENTS**

Return to inside of building  
Do business as usual

### **ADULTS**

Bring everyone indoors  
Lock outside doors  
Increase situational awareness  
Account for students and adults  
Do business as usual



## **LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.**

### **STUDENTS**

Move away from sight  
Maintain silence  
Do not open the door

### **ADULTS**

Recover students from hallway if possible  
Lock the classroom door  
Turn out the lights  
Move away from sight  
Maintain silence  
Do not open the door  
Prepare to evade or defend



## **EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)**

### **STUDENTS**

Leave stuff behind if required to  
If possible, bring your phone  
Follow instructions

### **ADULTS**

Lead students to Evacuation location  
Account for students and adults  
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults



## **SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy.**

### **STUDENTS**

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard

### **Hazard**

Tornado  
Hazmat  
Earthquake  
Tsunami

### **Safety Strategy**

Evacuate to shelter area  
Seal the room  
Drop, cover and hold  
Get to high ground

### **ADULTS**

Lead safety strategy  
Account for students and adults  
Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults



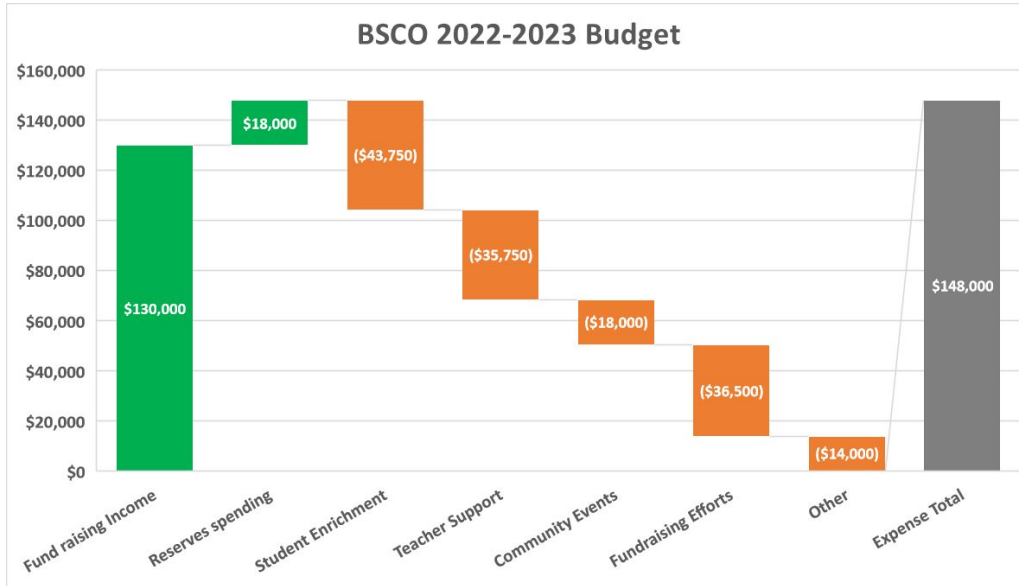

# Treasurer's Report



- **We finished 2021-2022 school year at \$56k with Covid curtailing many activities.**
- **This school year forecast at \$148k with the expectation of a normal school year.**
  - 54% of budget goes to teacher and student support and 12% towards community events.
  - Teacher support of \$36k includes funds for classroom support (\$500/teacher) as well programs like OBOB, Living things unit, Kindergarten Phonics, Salmon Tank, Library/Tech Center TV etc.
  - Student Enrichment of \$55k supports Science school, field trips, artist in residence, class parties, Geo Club, 5th grade send-off etc.
  - Community events of \$18k funded from BSCO reserves and supports events like Monster Mash, Carnival, Back to School, Pantry provisions, principal funds etc.
