

IN AN EMERGENCY **TAKE ACTION**



STUDENTS

Clear the hallways and remain in room or area until the "All Clear" is announced Do business as usual

Close and lock the door Account for students and adults Do business as usual



SECURE! Get inside. Lock outside doors. STUDENTS ADULTS

Return to inside of building Do business as usual

Bring everyone indoors Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students and adults Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight.

STUDENTS Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door

ADULTS Recover students from hallway if possible Lock the classroom door Turn out the lights Move away from sight Maintain silence Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified)

STUDENTS Leave stuff behind if required to If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

ADULTS Lead students to Evacuation location Account for students and adults Notify if missing, extra or injured students or adults



SHELTER! Hazard and safety strategy. STUDENTS ADULTS

Use appropriate safety strategy for the hazard






Treasurer's Report

Treasurer's Report



- We finished 2021-2022 school year at \$56k with Covid curtailing many activities.
- This school year forecast at \$148k with the expectation of a normal school year.
 - 54% of budget goes to teacher and student support and 12% towards community events.
 - Teacher support of \$36k includes funds for classroom support (\$500/teacher) as well programs like OBOB, Living things unit, Kindergarten Phonics, Salmon Tank, Library/Tech Center TV etc.
 - Student Enrichment of \$55k supports Science school, field trips, artist in residence, class parties, Geo Club, 5th grade send-off etc.
 - Community events of \$18k funded from BSCO reserves and supports events like Monster Mash, Carnival, Back to School, Pantry provisions, principal funds etc.

FUNDRAISING

- BSCO Budget Pre-COVID: \$145,000
- BSCO Budget 2020-21: \$40,000
- BSCO Budget 2021-22: \$65,000
- BSCO Budget 2022-23: \$148,000
