By- law Amendment

- As-is
 - BSCO board can approve funding asks up to \$1000 on their own. Any ask that comes in at \$1000 or over must be approved via community vote in a separate community meeting, requiring a 10 day notice of intent
- Proposal
 - Increase the board approval amount to \$5000
- Reasons
 - o Inflation/Increase of costs of goods amount has not been updated since 2008
 - Decrease in community engagement at community meetings
 - Increased ease for future board members
- Vote : Approved (65% Yes)

Volunteer Report by Erica Director of Volunteers

- 826 registered volunteers but only 20% are actively participating
- Our goal this year is to have all families donate one hour per school year
- Without active support, we will have to stop offering some events
