What is **BSCO**




Things to Know about BSCO

- Who is BSCO: All parents, guardians, teachers, and staff
- What does BSCO do?
 - Support BSE educators!
 - Enrichment activities before, during & after school!
 - Have fun!!!! (social & community events)
 - Fundraise for projects beyond
 BSE budget

- What does BSCO <u>not</u> do?
 - BSCO doesn't seek to direct or control
 BSE policies or administration
 - BSCO doesn't intervene or participate
 in political campaigns or attempt to
 influence legislation
- BSCO Board members are not compensated - volunteers trying to help!

BSCO 2023-24 Goals

- Continue to support BSE educators
 - Understand where funds are most needed, allocate appropriately
- Enrich in-person learning with BSCO sponsored events
- Increase Volunteer Engagement
 - Make a family pledge to volunteer *at least one hour* this school year
- Build sense of community
 - Create more events and opportunities for families to connect. Bring back pre-pandemic community levels
 - Provide diverse, equitable and inclusive event programming
- Be a resource
 - Continue to update new BSCO website & share on social media
 - Create additional new family/welcome to BSE resources



By-Law Amendment

- The BSCO Board is asking the community to approve an update to the BSCO By-laws (last updated in 2017). As it stands today, the BSCO board can approve funding asks up to \$1000 on their own. Any ask that comes in at \$1000 or over must be approved via community vote in a separate community meeting, requiring a 10 day notice of intent.
- We are asking to increase the board approval amount to \$5000 for multiple reasons
 - Inflation/Increase of costs of goods (\$1K number was set in 2008)
 - Decrease in community engagement at community meetings/lack of voters to approve
 - Increased ease for future board members approving a larger increase now would minimize multiple by-law updates as inflation/cost of goods increases

By-Law Amendment

- \circ Recent examples that exceeded the \$1K limit
 - Teacher Sunshine Fund (\$5K)
 - BSD Safe Route to Schools supplies (\$2250)
 - Garden Improvements (\$5-7K)
 - Picnic tables on playground (\$2.5K)
 - Playground cover (\$7K)
 - BSCO Storage Unit (\$1.2K)
 - Book Room Update (\$5K)
 - Paper Fund Increase (\$1K)
 - Science Boards for Science Night (\$1K)
 - Recorders for 3-5th grade (\$2.3K)

By-Law Amendment

Proposal for community vote -

- Current: Any motion for which a vote would result in a policy change, including changes to these bylaws or the Articles of Incorporation, or expenditure of BSCO funds above one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and not previously approved as a part of the budget shall be brought before the membership at a community meeting.
- Proposed: Any motion for which a vote would result in a policy change, including changes to these bylaws or the Articles of Incorporation, or expenditure of BSCO funds above Five thousand dollars (\$5,000) and not previously approved as a part of the budget shall be brought before the membership at a community meeting.

• Logistics:

- Polls will pop up momentarily
- Bylaws require 50% +1 of the quorum to approve each proposal

We Need Volunteers

- As of today, we have 826 volunteers registered in myImpact, and only about 20% of those are actively participating in volunteer opportunities. Our current volunteers are burning out and aging out. We are very concerned about the lack of engagement from our community post-covid.
- BSCO staffs these in-school activities that are in need of and are struggling to find adequate volunteer support:
 - Library/Tech Support
 - Lost and Found Support
 - Production Room Support
 - Friday Folders
 - Vision Screening
 - School Picture day

- *If all families were to donate ONE hour of their time per school year, many of our volunteer needs would ease significantly.*
- Direct teacher/classroom requests (reading support, math help, etc)

We Need Volunteers - Committees Level

- **Monster Mash** nearly didn't happened due to lack of leadership and volunteers. Some real heroes stepped in at the last minute.
- **Art Literacy** volunteers are leading multiple lessons each month due to lack of larger volunteer engagement.
- Walk to School was not able to secure leadership and had to be left to individual family participation.
- Fifth Grade Activities is having a hard time finding additional leadership and support.
- **B.E.S.T., Science Night, Pancake Breakfast***, and **Community Outreach** do not have committee leads.
- **OBOB** is currently seeking a co-lead.
- We have no **Jog A Thon** lead for next year, which raises over half of our yearly budget.
- Several leads from existing committees have said they do NOT want to return to lead next year. *Without active volunteer support, we will have to stop offering all events/committees each year.*

- Fundraisers: Budget \$245k (net proceeds \$186k)
 - Auction, Jog-A-Thon, Matching Funds, Pancake Breakfast, BSCO Reserves
- Teacher and School Support: Budget \$62.5k
 - Teacher Funds, Educational Support, Teacher Grants, etc.
- Student Enrichment: Budget \$67.5k
 - Science School, Field Trips, Class Parties, Art Lit, etc.
- Community Events: Budget \$26k
 - Back to School, Monster Mash, Carnival, etc.
- Community Giving: Budget \$10k
 - Pantry Provisions, Principal Fund, etc.
- BSCO Administration: Budget \$20k
 - Tax prep, Insurance, Discretionary
